PREPARING TO LEAVE FOR BOCCONI CHECKLIST	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>PASSPORT/ID:</b> Bring with you all the <b>documents</b> required to enter Italy. Pack them last, and remember where you put them! Without having these settled, you will not be able to get into the country.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>SAFETY TIP:</b> Inform your national Consulate/Embassy or Foreign Affair Ministry (it depends on which institution handles this service) about your <b>flights</b> and <b>stay details</b> : hopefully you won't need their help but it may turn useful in the unlikely event of an emergency.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>INSURANCE COVERAGE:</b> Check if your health insurance <b>covers</b> you <b>abroad</b> for the entire duration of your exchange period, otherwise, you need to get a new insurance plan.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>MEDICATION:</b> Stock up on any prescription <b>drugs</b> you take. Have your doctor's <b>note</b> authorizing their use (and refills). Make sure that any over-the-counter drugs you carry are considered legal in Italy.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>HANDLE MONEY OVERSEAS:</b> Check and understand the <b>exchange rate</b> before you travel.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>SPORT ACTIVITIES:</b> In Italy, if you wish to practice any sport activities, you are required to show a <b>medical certificate</b> which specifies that you are in good health and able to do exercise. Bocconi Gym accepts only medical certificates in their original hard copy or fax with the wording: 'is able to perform non-competitive sport activities'.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>HAND BAGGAGE:</b> What if your luggage goes missing? Remember to remain calm, contact your airline company and make sure your hand luggage contains a <b>change of clothes!</b>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Last but not least: upon arrival, <b>call</b> your <b>parents</b> or friends to say that you are safe and sound in Milan. A Facebook post is not enough
